

**HANOVER LIVING HISTORY  
REENACTMENT SITE RULES AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY  
SEPTEMBER 17-19, 2016**

- 1) Respect all campsite properties. Dispose of all trash in cans and clean up the grounds after the event.
- 2) Fire pits need to be a safe distance from tents and public walkways. The sod needs to be properly replaced after the event.
- 3) All camps need to be secured by provost at all times.
- 4) All horses must be secured when not being ridden.
- 5) All re-enactors are responsible for their own belongings when onsite. If you don't want the public near your camp, please tell them so!! Event staff or organizers are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 6) Firewood will be available at one spot in each camp. Ice and water and watering troughs for the horses will also be available.
- 7) Company officers are responsible for firearms and use . During skirmishes firing of arms will on the field only. Discharge of arms to clear debris is recommended after the skirmish.
- 8) Noise is to be kept to minimum between the hours of 10p.m. and 7a.m.
- 9) Confederate command and union command will have radio communications for emergencies with event command.
- 10) All camps are urged to be talkative with the public and educate them. Try to fit the time period and location of the event.
- 11) Any other questions can be forwarded to event command.
- 12) In an emergency see your company commander and have them contact event command. Fire and EMS will be on the scene for the whole event.
